Hosted on the <u>Blended Learning Platform</u>, the online course programme forms an integral part of the <u>Nexus Observatory</u>. Through these online courses UNU-FLORES aims to provide participants with access to relevant knowledge, to help address capacity development needs and to allow for the development of new skills on how to apply the acquired knowledge in practice.

<u>Course fee</u>: The cost of participation will be \$250. This includes the cost for the textbook and mailing of DVDs containing course lectures.
